



Anglicans for Life, Christ Church Vero Beach, Special Report

**Thanks be to God! Data Shows
Significant Drop in Abortions
at the Ft. Pierce Abortion Center.**



We are pleased to report that since March there has been a significant drop* in the rate of unborn babies being aborted at the Ft. Pierce Planned Parenthood Abortion Center. Your prayers and generosity are being rewarded as the data shows an obvious trend that is very promising.

At the end of March 2019 there were 71 aborted babies. By the end of September, the rate had dropped to 29. Still unacceptable, but never-the-less, a God inspired improvement.

During our Lenten 40 Days for Life campaign this year, 17 people from Vero Beach area Protestant churches – all new to this local pro-life ministry – prayed on Tuesdays at the Ft. Pierce abortuary. And nine babies were saved. During our Fall 40 Days for Life campaign, 11 people from area Protestant churches participated, and one set of twins' lives were spared. We want to give special thanks to the eight people who participated in both the Fall and Spring campaigns.

In an international effort, since 2007, 40 Days for Life has been at work in 61 countries with one million volunteers, 9,000 churches and 6,428 local campaigns. The mission to save lives and end abortion has resulted in 16,004 babies saved, 104 abortion centers closed, and 191 abortion workers leaving the industry.

We praise God for the unborn babies and their families' lives being saved, and for God answering prayer by providing laborers in this harvest. But more volunteers are needed. As the weeks went by, people dropped out for various reasons, resulting in hours uncovered by prayer. We're especially grateful to our Catholic brothers and sisters who filled in some Tuesday hours left uncovered by prayer during both campaigns.

Forty Days for Life prayer vigils bring Catholics and Protestants of different denominations together for a common cause – to share the message of the inherent worth and dignity of unborn children made in the image of God, and to end abortion. The Spring Lenten prayer vigil on Tuesdays had 10 participants from Christ Church, seven from other Protestant churches, and 14 from Catholic churches. During the Fall prayer vigil, 14 participated from Christ Church, five were from other Protestant churches, and five were from Catholic churches. There were a total of 31 participants in the Spring, which decreased to 23 in the Fall due to seasonal population fluctuation.

Thanks to everyone at Christ Church Vero Beach for making it possible to buy signs to witness to drivers passing by and literature for distribution on the sidewalk and used to encourage other Protestant churches in our community to participate. Christ Church also provided the funding to allow us to conduct our second annual training for those volunteering to counsel families intending abortion.
