## **Psalm 82**

**1.** Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, **2.** looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God. **3.** Consider him who endured from sinners such hostility against himself, so that you may not grow weary or fainthearted. **4.** In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. **5.** And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by him. **6.** For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives." **7.** It is for discipline that you have to endure. God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline? **8.** If you are left without discipline, in which all have participated, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. **9.** Besides this, we have had earthly fathers who disciplined us and we respected them. Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits and live? **10.** For they disciplined us for a short time as it seemed best to them, but he disciplines us for our good, that we may share his holiness. **11.** For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it. **12.** Therefore lift your drooping hands and strengthen your weak knees, **13.** and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be put out of joint but rather be

healed. **14.** Strive for peace with everyone, and for the holiness without which no one will see the Lord. (ESV)

**Nicene Creed** (*People stand*)

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, visible and invisible.

Holy and gracious Father: In your infinite love you made us for yourself; and when we had sinned against you and become subject to evil and death, you, in your mercy, sent your only Son Jesus Christ into the world for our salvation. By the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary he became flesh and dwelt among us. In obedience to your will, he stretched out his arms upon the Cross and offered himself once for all, that by his suffering and death we might be saved. By his resurrection he broke the bonds of death,

trampling Hell and Satan under his feet. As our great high priest, he ascended to your right hand in glory, that we might come with confidence before the throne of grace.

On the night that he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying, “Take, eat; this is my Body, which is given for you: Do this in remembrance of me.”

Likewise, after supper, Jesus took the cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, “Drink this, all of you; for this is my Blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you, and for many, for the forgiveness of sins: Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me.”

Therefore, we proclaim the mystery of faith:

*Celebrant and People*

*Christ has died.*

*Christ is risen.*

*Christ will come again.*

We celebrate the memorial of our redemption, O Father, in this sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving, and we offer you these gifts. Sanctify them by your Word and Holy Spirit to be for your people the Body and Blood of your Son Jesus Christ. Sanctify us also, that we may worthily receive this holy Sacrament, and be made one body with him, that he may dwell in us and we in him. In the fullness of time, put all things in subjection under your Christ, and bring us with all your saints

into the joy of your heavenly kingdom, where we shall see our Lord face to face.

All this we ask through your Son Jesus Christ: By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory is yours, Almighty Father, now and for ever. *Amen.*

And now as our Savior Christ has taught us, we are bold to pray:

*Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory forever and ever. Amen.*



### **CONNECT WITH CHRIST CHURCH**

We are glad you're here! Our Connect Cards and Prayer Cards are available in the Narthex on the information desk. Please include your contact information along with your comments, needs, or prayer requests and hand your card to an usher. We look forward to serving you in person or in prayer.

*In the event of an emergency requiring evacuation, children and infants will be escorted from the classroom onto the playground at the south end of the building and supervised there until the parents arrive.*

### **CHILDREN'S MINISTRY:**

The Children's Ministry area is open at 9:00 am on Sunday mornings for nursery to 5th Grade. During the 10:30 am Sunday service, we provide lessons to children in addition to nursery care for the first part of the service, after which the children may join their families in the Nave for Holy Communion.

### **RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION:**

All baptized Christians are welcome to the Table of Christ to receive Holy Communion. Ushers will guide your row to the altar rail, and a wafer will be placed in your hand; you may intinct (dip) the edge of the wafer into the wine chalice, or sip from the common cup, or abstain. Anyone wishing to not receive the sacrament is welcome to come forward for a spoken blessing only, signified by crossing your arms over your chest.
